Dear Parents and Students,

For Students:

All students should meet in the HHS band room at **5:15 p.m** in full uniform (full marching uniform, black socks, black shoes, and rain jacket.) Do not be late! We will quickly do a run before departing for Zeeland High School. The buses will depart from HHS by **5:45**. Our warm-up time is at **6:30** and our performance time is at **7:15**. Following our performance students can return to the buses to exchange their marching band hat/instrument for their rain jacket, but will remain in full uniform. **Students must sit together in assigned area!** Students may purchase food from concession stands. Awards are at **9:15** and we will be returning to HHS by **9:45 p.m.** *Please consult student expectations located on the next page*

Full Adults:

Chaperones and front ensemble movers are needed for this event. If you already signed up to chaperone you have two options: **1.** Ride the busses that are departing at **5:45 p.m.** from the new parking lot or **2.** Meet the band at the Zeeland Parking lot by **6:15 p.m** to help with equipment. Chaperones and equipment movers are encouraged to help with our performance and then sit and enjoy the rest of the performances with the band. Welcome to the Zeeland High School site for 2012. This, in addition to the email attachments, should be all the info that you will need to ensure that your performance proceeds smoothly. We are very excited to be hosting again this year, and we hope that your performance here will be an excellent one.

Our band parents will be assisting you upon arrival. Buses should drop off students at the ***SOUTH*** end of the stadium; this is right near the band entrance/exit area, so please be courteous and quiet. Warm-up areas are marked on the map – please face south to play. Our guides will make sure you know exactly where you are going. We have allowed fifteen minutes for trooping to the staging area; it's not as far as it looks on the map.

For those who have played here before, please take note of the entry/exit points of the field. There are two gates at the south end, and we will enter AND exit the field from there. Spectators now enter the north end, so we will not have a traffic flow problem as we have had before.

We will provide an announcer for you; please send me an email with your publicity, etc. You may provide your own announcer if you wish – just send him or her to the press box before your band plays.

Our concession stand *should* be open on the home side for your enjoyment.

No schools will be allowed access to the press box for taping – access to the roof is right through the press box, which would be distracting to the judges. MSBOA is providing a DVD for each band.

Following your performance, please instruct your group to sit in the visitors' bleachers, or on the home side if there is room.

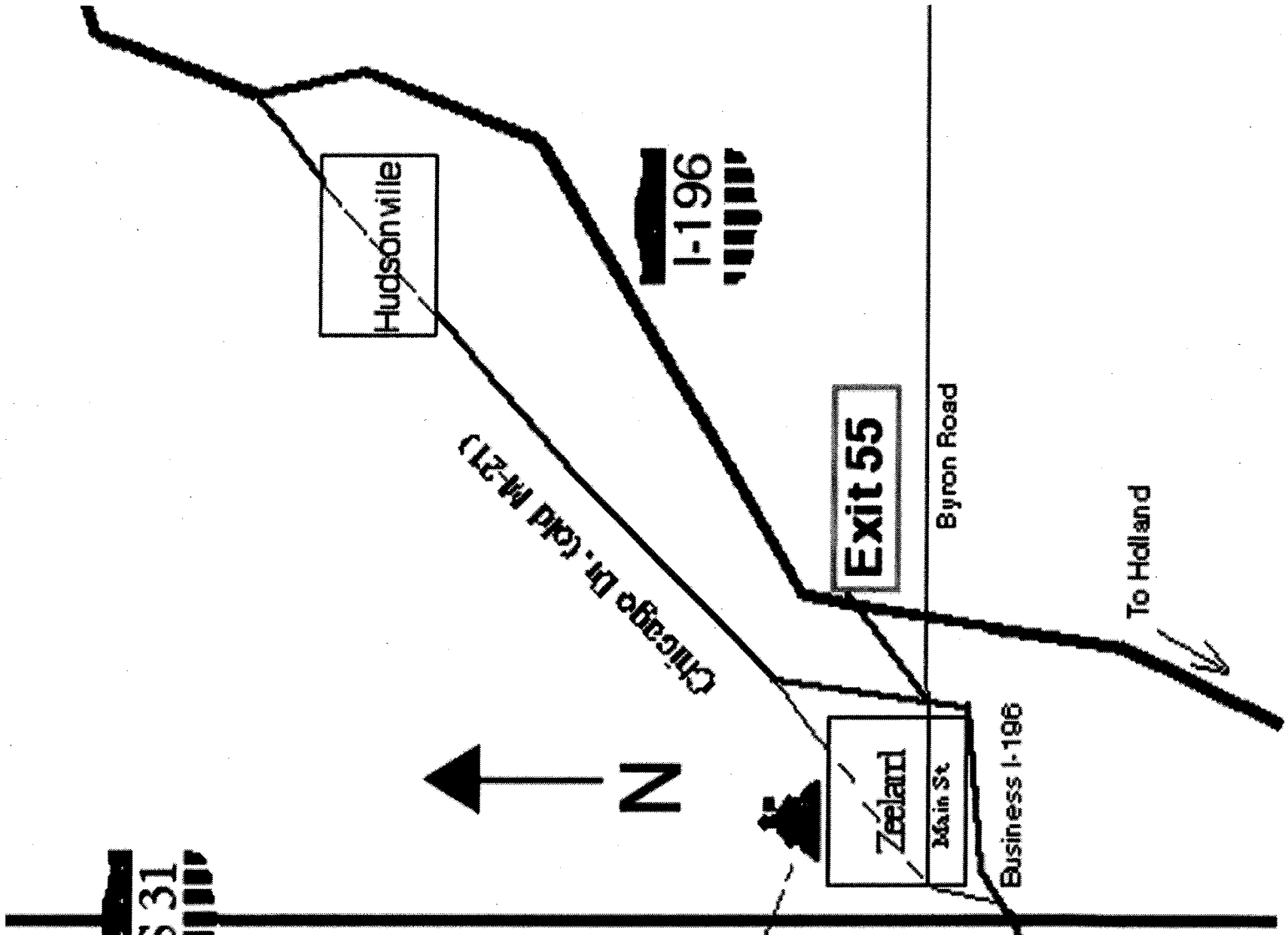
